A Summer Day Flower Press

Supplies needed

7 pieces of corrugated cardboard (from a mailing box) cut to 4" X 6"

6 pieces pieces of printer paper or newspaper cut to 4" X 6"

1 piece of scrapbook paper cut to 4" X 6" glue stick

1 label (cut from below) or stickers to decorate your cover

2 elastic bands

Instructions

- 1. Cover 1 piece of cardboard with the scrapbook paper.
- 2. Decorate the cover with one of the labels below and/or stickers of your choice.
- 3. Gather flowers, leaves, grasses or small ferns that are in good condition.
- 4. Place 1 piece of cardboard, 1 piece of paper, the specimen, 1 piece of paper and 1 piece of cardboard.
- 5. Continue piling in that order, ending with the cover.
- 6. Wrap each side with 1 elastic band.
- 7. Check specimens occasionally. Drying can take up to 2 weeks depending on the moisture in the plant material.
- 8. Pressed flowers and leaves are ready when they are firm.

These flowers can be glued to paper to make a scrapbook collection, added to note cards, or decoupaged to projects to decorate them. The flower colors might fade over time.
